

MASK ACTIVITY

Objective

- To provide the students with a visual aid in understanding the effects of sin (to be used in conjunction with "The Mask of Sin" handout)

Materials

- Mask patterns
- Safety scissors
- Crayons
- Markers
- Stickers
- Glue sticks
- Sequins
- Gems
- Glitter

Procedure

- Partially prepare the mask patterns before giving them to the students - cut out the eyes using scissors or an exacto knife. Prepare an example of a finished mask to show the students before beginning their work.
- Distribute the patterns and scissors to the students. Explain that the mask will be a symbol to help understand a part of their upcoming lesson.
- Help the students as they decorate their masks. Suggest embellishments to students who have trouble or lose interest.
- Distribute and introduce "The Mask of Sin" handout. Ask the students to read along as the handout is read aloud. When the paragraph which begins "Choosing to sin is like hiding behind a mask" is read, ask the students to hold their masks to their faces. When the last sentence of the paragraph ("He wants to pull off the mask of sin so that he can see our beautiful faces again.") is read aloud, ask the students to remove their masks.
